2023 AGRICULTURAL PEST CONTROL BUSINESS REGISTRATION

Dear Pest Control Operator,

This letter is to inform you that the registration allowing your Pest Control Business to conduct operations in San Bernardino County will expire on December 31, 2022. You **must register by January 1, 2023** in order to continue your business in San Bernardino County during the 2023 calendar year.

As provided in California Food and Agricultural Code § 11732, *“It is unlawful for any person to advertise, solicit, or operate as a pest control business in any county unless the person has registered with the commissioner for the current calendar year.”*

In order to register your business, you must submit all of the following:

- A **completed registration form** (including an equipment list, if applicable).
- A copy of your current and valid Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) issued **Pest Control Business license**.
- A copy of a current and valid **QAL card** for the person qualifying your business.
- 2023 registration payment of **\$96.60**.

Pesticide Use Reports (including “Negative Use” reports) are to be submitted online using the CalAgPermits website (www.calagpermits.org). If you cannot access the CalAgPermits, please contact our office.
