2026 MAINTENANCE GARDENER BUSINESS REGISTRATION

Dear Maintenance Gardener Operator,

This letter is to inform you that the registration allowing your Maintenance Gardener Business to conduct operations in San Bernardino County will expire on December 31, 2025. You must register by January 1, 2026, in order to continue your business in San Bernardino County during the 2026 calendar year.

As provided in California Food and Agricultural Code § 11732,

"It is unlawful for any person to advertise, solicit, or operate as a pest control business in any county unless the person has registered with the commissioner for the current calendar year."

In order to register your business, you must submit all of the following:

- > A completed registration form.
- > A copy of your current and valid Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) issued Maintenance Gardener Business License.
- A copy of a current and valid **QAL** or **QAC card** for the person qualifying your business.
- 2026 registration payment of \$25.00.

Maintenance Gardeners who possess a QAC with only Category Q are not allowed to obtain a Restricted Materials Permit.

Pesticide Use Reports (including "Negative Use" reports) are to be submitted online using the CalAgPermits website (www.calagpermits.org). If you cannot access the CalAgPermits website, please contact our office at (909) 387-2105.
