2026 PESTICIDE USE PERMIT RENEWAL

Important information regarding the renewal of your 2026 Pesticide Use Permit:

Renewal Period:

- Permits expiring on December 31, 2025 (Restricted Material or Operator) Identification) must be renewed prior to applying any pesticides in 2026.
- The issuance of 2026 permits will begin on November 1, 2025. No permits for 2026 will be issued before this date.

Renewal Methods:

- Email: You may renew your permit by email. Please provide your company's name, permit number, the type of permit you are requesting (such as restricted material or OP ID) and the best contact number to call you and email it to awm@awm.sbcountv.gov.
- Phone: Call (909) 387-2105 to schedule an appointment.

Restricted Materials Permits:

- If you or your direct employees apply restricted pesticides on your property, you must present a valid Private Applicator Certificate (PAC) that is effective until at least December 31, 2026.
- All property operators must have a permit, even if a Pest Control Business handles their pesticide applications.
- Entities like government agencies and golf courses applying restricted materials must have a Qualified Applicator License (QAL) or Qualified Applicator Certificate (QAC) holder on staff.
- All Qualified Applicators (QAL/QAC holders) who perform pest control using a pesticide labeled as a fumigant must obtain a Soil Fumigation (Category L) and/or Non-Soil Fumigation (Category M). Private Applicators must obtain the Burrowing Vertebrate Pest Fumigation Certificate.
